



Supplement vs. Supplant Methodology

Purpose: Ensure equitable budgeting for all schools; benefit schools, staff, and families

Methodology: State and local funds are distributed to each site equally regardless of their Title I status. Allocations are based on the projected student enrollment count per year.

State and local funds include Maintenance and Operation, School Plant Funds, Capital Funds as well as any other local funds granted by the state intended for schools.

State and local funds are used to provide classroom/program materials and supplies, printing, staffing, auxiliary services, extracurricular programs, and other subjects related supplies to ensure that each school can function adequately for the purpose of supporting academic needs.

Staffing for all schools is based on an approved teacher-student ratio without regard to individual site's participation in federally funded programs.

District leadership collectively monitors all activities, expenditures, and functions to ensure that federal dollars are used to supplement and not supplant state and local funds.
